Misuse Exercise Answers

Scenario 1



- Age: 6 months
- Weight: 8.2 kg (18 lb)
- Label on seat:
Forward-facing 10-29.5 kg (22-65 lb)

- Must be rear-facing
- Incorrect belt path

Scenario 2



- Age: 3 years
- Weight: 14.5 kg (32 lb)
- Label: weight limit 18 kg (40 lb)

- Harness not over shoulders

Scenario 3



- Age: 11 months
- Weight: 10.4 kg (23 lb)
- Label: weight limit 10 kg (22 lb)

- Must be rear-facing
- Too big for restraint

Scenario 4



- Age: 5 years old
- Weight: 25 kg (55 lb)
- Height: 105.9 cm (3'6")

- Must be in a booster seat
- No shoulder belt under the arm

Scenario 5



- Age: 2 years old
- Weight: 13.6 kg (30 lb)
- Label: Forward-facing 10-29.5 kg (22-65 lb)

- Correctly buckled into seat
- Harness snug and at correct level
- Chest clip position correct
- UAS attached
- Forward-facing position
