1. Meet the following prerequisites:
 - Active BCAA CPS Educator II certification in good standing
 - Have at least one year experience as a BCAA CPS Educator II
2. Complete and submit the BCAA CPS Educator Instructor Application Form
3. Be interviewed by the Senior BCAA CPS Educator Instructor
4. Observe and assist in a CPS Educator II Course
5. Demonstrate your ability to organize and teach a CPS Educator II Course

Upon successful completion of all requirements the applicant will receive a BCAA CPS Educator Instructor Certificate of Completion.

To maintain your CPS Educator Instructor status, you will need to:

- Maintain your BCAA CPS Educator status:
 - Participate in one or more of the following activities on an annual basis:
 - Information session
 - Hands-On workshop
 - Child Seat Clinic
 - Complete the online BCAA CPS Educator Competency Review every two years.
- Facilitate at least one BCAA CPS Educator II Course a year.
